In the 1d. the different stages are distinguished by differences in the scratches appearing on stamps Row 15/1, Row 16/1, Row 16/1 and 2, and Row 16/1, 2 and 3.

- 1. Row 15/1. Line through "SUID-AFRIK."
- 2. Row 15/1. Line through "SUID-AFRIK" but smudged at bottom of "d" in 1d. in left value tablet and at right through "RIK."
- 3. Row 15/1. A second scratch below the last one from "." of "1d." left value tablet through "SUID-AFRIK."



Fourth stage of scratches.

- Row 15/1. The same two scratches as in 3. Row 16/1. Two scratches through "D-AFRIKA" into margin.
- Row 15/1. A third scratch through "FRIKA" above the others. Row 16/1. The same.
 - Row 16/2. Scratch through "FRICA" into margin.
 - Row 16/3. Scratch through "D-AF."

(The order in which the above variations occurred in the interior and exterior cylinders has not yet been established.)
